

GAC Laser Durban secured the handling and export packing of citrus fruit intended for ambient handling prior to packing and chilling in reefer containers. The first fruit arrived in April with lemons and grapefruit being handled and packed followed by oranges from July through to mid September. We have handled approximately 13,000 pallets into storage and have packed over 500 x 40' containers for the season. Our main client is Go Reefers, who are a Global Perishable Logistics provider offering a solution from the farm to global overseas markets. They partnered with us to handle their customer's ambient requirements in Durban as their cold store cannot accommodate the additional volumes. Their ambient team, as well as The Perishable Products Export Control Board (PPECB) personnel are based at our facility in Jacobs to ensure compliance with regulations and maintaining the integrity of the fruit throughout the handling, storage and packing process.
